Narrative description of the Prop 28 art education program(s) funded.

During the 2024-25 school year, our Prop 28 funds were used to enrich elementary arts programming by expanding both music and drama opportunities. Specifically, we purchased new sets of musical instruments - including Orff instruments - to support classroom music instruction. These instruments are now used by all grade levels TK-5 during weekly music classes and school-wide performances.

In addition, Prop 28 funding helped compensate two certificated music teachers whose roles include leading class ensembles, co-curricular choir, and supporting seasonal musicals.

These investments represent a true expansion of our arts offerings: adding new instruments, and boosting drama instruction completely supplementing, not supplanting, our existing programs. As a result, nearly 700 elementary students across both our North and South campuses received enhanced arts instruction.
