While there is no new facilities decision to share just yet, we want to assure you that our Board and leadership team are working diligently behind the scenes, thoughtfully exploring the best path forward with LASD. Our focus remains unchanged: finding a lasting facilities solution that gives our students the space they need to learn, grow, and thrive. Our next meeting with LASD is this week. If there are any significant developments then, we'll be sure to share those with you after the meeting. Otherwise, you can expect to hear our next Sunday Facilities Update on Sunday, October 4.

Additionally, in recent materials shared by LASD, enrollment of our out-of-district students and its financial impact on the broader community were highlighted. At tomorrow's board meeting, we'll be presenting important information that will help ensure the full picture is understood.

As we navigate this process together, here is what you can count on from us:

- We're committed to collaborating with LASD on a sustainable, long-term agreement that supports both school communities.
- A full evaluation of our options before the Prop 39 deadline so we can make the most informed decision.
- Ensure the facility we inhabit protects and enriches the academic, arts, and community experiences that make our school special.
- A consistent reporting schedule with open and transparent communications that keep you informed with meaningful news while avoiding premature speculation.
